Students are asked to create a recyclable piece of art or a functioning new item in 60 minutes. All items are supplied and will vary in number and size. Participants are only allowed to use the items provided in the odds and ends area. One entry form per person.

- Rules
- This contest is open to students from 4th through 12th grades only.
- All allowable items will be provided for the student at the beginning of the contest.
- Recyclable creations will be judged on creativity, execution, and if it is finished in the allotted sixty minutes.
- We ask that the final product remain at the fair on display until the close on Sept. 14, 2024.
- There is no charge for this event. However, an entry form is required for each entry.
- If the fair committee or its representatives deem an entry inappropriate, it will be removed from the judging and display area.
- All entry forms must be received by the Habersham County Extension Office by September 3rd at 5 pm. Forms may emailed to uge1137@uga.edu. You may mail them to 555 Monroe St., Unit 50, Clarkesville, GA 30523. Mailed entries must be postmarked by August 24, 2024. Or, you may drop them off at that address between 8:00-12:00 and 1:00-5:00 Monday-Friday.
- The Fair Committee reserves the right to cancel this competition if there is a lack of participation.
- Walk-up participants will be allowed if enough materials are available.
- Entry into fair contests provides the entrant free admission to the fair on Saturday, September 7, 2024. Multiple entries do not equal multiple admissions. Parents and other family or friends will not be admitted free of charge. Walk-up participants will not be reimbursed for entry fees.
