## **Rules**

- This contest is open to students K through 12th grades.
- How creative can you be? The only restriction for this contest is it must be school and 4-H appropriate.
- If the fair committee or its representatives deem an entry inappropriate, it will be removed from the judging and display area.
- The work needs to be primarily done by the student with minimal help from adults.
- Any type of boot is acceptable. I.e., rainboot, cowboy boots, work boots, hiking & riding boots, etc. Boots may be altered, but at least 50% of the boot must remain.
- There is no charge for this event. However, an entry form is required for each entry.
- The Habersham County Extension Office must receive all entry forms by September 3, 2024. Forms may be emailed to uge1137@uga.edu. You may mail them to 555 Monroe St., Unit 50, Clarkesville, GA 30523. Mailed entries must be postmarked by August 24, 2024. Or, you may drop them off at that address between 8:00-12:00 and 1:00-5:00 Monday-Friday. Entries may be turned in at the office with prior arrangements. Items should be dropped off at the fairgrounds on Thursday, Sept. 5, 2024, between 3-6:30 pm.
- The Fair Committee reserves the right to cancel this competition if there is a lack of participation.
- Entry into fair contests provides the entrant free admission to the fair on Saturday, September 7, 2024. Multiple entries do not equal multiple admissions. Parents and other family or friends will not be admitted free of charge. Walk-up participants will not be reimbursed for entry fees.
