Rules

- This contest is open to students from K through 12th grades. Entries will be divided into K-3, 4-6th, and 9-12th grades.
- Entries may fall into, but are not limited to, the following categories: Decorated Garments, Home Accessories, General Crafts, Ceramics, Woodworking, Drawing/Painting, or other artistic or crafting mediums.
- Entries must be made entirely by the child whose name appears on this form. Age-appropriate supervision and instruction are allowed.
- Entries will be displayed until the end of the Chattahoochee Mountain Fair and may be picked up at the Habersham County Extension office the week after the fair closes. More extensive entries will be handled at the discretion of the event coordinator.
- There is no charge for this event; however, an entry form is required for each entry.
- If any entry is deemed inappropriate by the fair committee or its representatives, it will be removed from the judging and display area.
- All entry forms must be received by the Habersham County Extension Office by September 3 at 5 pm. Forms may emailed to uge1137@uga.edu. You may mail them to 555 Monroe St., Unit 50, Clarkesville, GA 30523. Mailed entries must be postmarked by August 24, 2024. Or, you may drop them off at that address between 8:00-12:00 and 1:00-5:00 Monday-Friday.
- Entries may be delivered to the fairgrounds between 3:00 and 6:30 pm on Thursday, September 5, 2024, or to the Habersham County Extension office before then. Entries must stay at the fair until Saturday, September 14, 2024.
- The Fair Committee will not be responsible for lost or stolen entries.
- All entries must be labeled inconspicuously with the child's name, school, and grade.
- The Fair Committee reserves the right to cancel this competition if there is a lack of participation.
- Entry into fair contests provides the entrant free admission to the fair on Saturday, September 7, 2024. Multiple entries do not equal multiple admissions. Parents and other family or friends will not be admitted free of charge.
- We must receive your entry to grant access to the fair.
- Please contact the Habersham County 4-H office at 706-839-0250 with any questions.
- Students may only enter two (2) pieces for judging.
- Entries may be picked up at the Extension office after the fair. All entries not picked up by September 15 between 12–2 pm will become property of the Chattahoochee Mountain Fair and may be subject to destruction, use in promotional materials, or any other use deemed fit by the fair committee.
