One entry form per person. 1st place: \$20, 2nd: \$15, 3rd: \$10, 4th: \$5 & 5th: ribbon. K-3 prizes are awarded from the prize box. No cash awards for this age division. • Rules

- This contest is open to students from K through 12th grades.
- The following items will be provided for the student: salt dough for sculpting and decorating, various tools, some items for decorations, and a plate for presentation.
- Sculptures will be judged on creativity, execution, and if it is finished in the allotted thirty minutes.
- Sculptures may be taken home after the contest or left for display at the fair.
- **DUE TO RAW FLOUR, THE DOUGH IS NOT SAFE FOR CONSUMPTION**
- There is no charge for this event. However, an entry form is required for each entry.
- If the fair committee or its representatives deem an entry inappropriate, it will be removed from the judging and display area.
- All entry forms must be received by the Habersham County Extension Office by September 3rd at 5 pm. Forms may emailed to uge1137@uga.edu. You may mail them to 555 Monroe St., Unit 50, Clarkesville, GA 30523. Mailed entries must be postmarked by August 24, 2024. Or, you may drop them off at that address between 8:00-12:00 and 1:00-5:00 Monday-Friday.
- The Fair Committee reserves the right to cancel this competition if there is a lack of participation.
- Walk-up participants will be allowed if enough materials are available.
- Entry into fair contests provides the entrant free admission to the fair on Saturday, September 7, 2024. Multiple entries do not equal multiple admissions. Parents and other family or friends will not be admitted free of charge. Walk-up participants will not be reimbursed for entry fees.
- Contact Habersham County 4-H Office at 706-839-0250 with any questions.
- Photos of the salt dough sculpture entries will be taken and displayed for the remainder of the fair.
- The items used in the contest may come in contact with gluten, tree nuts, wheat, milk, soy, eggs, artificial dyes, and other allergens.
